

In anticipation of a late Spring snow, Crofton CC, Crofton, MD sprayed Revert on Sunday, March 16, 2014, on their 5 wettest greens: 11,12,14,15,16.

They had the idea to try it out ahead of the snowstorm to help these greens dry out after the snow melted. What they did not anticipated was that it would actually speed up the melting process!



The good news was that the soil temperatures were much warmer and the angle of the sun is also on our side to assist melting.



By 3:00 P.M. the green was free of snow as a result of melting and increased infiltration and penetration of water.



With the snow clearing off all 5 greens, the superintendent commented that they had several extra days to dry out while the snow melted off the rest of the course.
